Highly flammable liquid and vapour. Read and understand the Safety Data Sheet before using this product.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Prior to applying Bostik N49 Primer the substrate must be sound, dry, clean and free from any dust, residue or contamination and meet the requirements of substrate preparation detailed in the applicable Polyurethane Sealant Technical Data Sheet. Bostik primers or sealants must not be applied to unpredictable absorptive surfaces such as marble, limestone or granite unless a standard of appearance has been agreed upon as a

result of testing for stain and/or discoloration.

APPLICATION

- Apply with a soft brush allowing a minimum drying time of 15 minutes before applying sealant.
- Bostik N49 is moisture sensitive and will commence curing when exposed to ambient moisture. To maximize adhesion results:
 - Decant the required quantity that can be applied by brush within 30 minutes into a clean, dry

container.

- Primer that changes colour or becomes thicker has commenced to cure and should be discarded.
- Avoid dipping the same brush into the original container unless the entire contents are applied in 30 minutes.
- o Use a clean, dry container on each decant to avoid contamination and shortened pot life.
- Discard any unused primer; do not pour any unused primer back into any remaining original primer in the original container.
- Sealant must be applied within 4 hours or re-priming is required.
- A sample test application is recommended on all substrates as staining may occur where the primer has been applied to areas not covered by polyurethane sealant

LIMITATIONS

 Bostik N49 is not suitable for application on nonporous substrates such as hard plastics and ferrous or non-ferrous metals. Refer Bostik N40 Primer Technical Data Sheet for non- porous substrate applications.

CLEANING

Bostik No. 2 Solvent or Mineral Turpentine. Use Bostik Handy Wipe towels to remove adhesive from skin.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store in cool, dry conditions out of direct sunlight below 30°C and away from naked flame or sources of heat. Store according to Dangerous Goods regulations. Shelf life is 12 months if stored in cool, dry conditions in original, unopened containers.

DISPOSAL

Empty containers, once dry, may be disposed of via local landfill.

If spilt, beware of flammable vapours. Absorb product with clay, sand or earth. Collect in properly labelled metal containers. Dispose of according to local authority regulations. Do not dispose of down drains or into waterways. Fully dried material is not hazardous.
